Maria Rypan of Toronto is an international designer and instruction book publisher recognized for her Ukrainian-style of beading and interest in global folk arts. She has become a recognized expert in Ukrainian-style beadwork. Her specialties are netting, unique bead weaving and loom weaving techniques. In 1995 she wanted to share this unique tradition with like-minded cultural enthusiasts so she developed a series of beadwork classes with her own instructional material. Her work is featured in many beadwork publications.

Since 1995 she has been teaching internationally, producing a kit line, and lecturing on beading and global folk arts. Her research trips to Ukraine yield fresh material about folk costumes, adornments and trends. Maria taught master classes, showed presentations in Ukraine since 2010.

This annual event, organized by Heritage Winnipeg, provides an opportunity for Winnipeggers to explore many historical and unusual buildings in the city. Oseredok has been participating in Doors Open Winnipeg since 2010 inviting people to learn about the history of its facility. Our building has landmark visibility from Main Street and the Disraeli freeway. It was erected in 1912 by the British and Foreign Bible Society at a cost of \$75,000 and was known for a long time as Bible House.

In 1949 it was sold to the Ukrainian National Publishing Company, publishers of the Ukrainian newspaper *New Pathway (Новий шлях)*. In 1977 it was purchased by Oseredok and continues to be Oseredok's home ever since.



Visit Oseredok on Saturday, May 27 to discover some of the treasures we hold in this historical building. Three behind-the-scenes group tours will be offered at 10:30, 12:30 and 2:30. You can sign up for a tour by calling 204-942-0218. Admission is free.

This summer Plast Ukrainian Scouting Association is holding an international jamboree near Mittenwald, Germany exactly 50 years since it held its first jamboree outside Ukraine near this city.

The occasion in 1947 was the celebration of the 35th anniversary of Plast. Between 1945 and 1948 Plast functioned in approximately 80 Displaced Persons (DP) camps in post-World War II Germany. It attracted some 4,800 members with its patriotic scouting program. The goal of the 1947 jamboree was to bring Plast youth together before the great exodus from the DP camps to North and South America, Australia and other parts of Europe that ensued between 1948 and 1952.




