



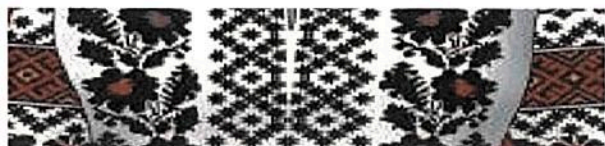

Spotlight on ...

Diplomatic Passport of the Ukrainian National Republic,
Switzerland, 1920



A Diplomatic Passport of the Ukrainian National Republic was issued to Yevhen Sokovitch, Counsellor of the Special Diplomatic Mission of Ukraine. It was signed by Nykolai Vasyly'ko, Extraordinary Envoy and Plenipotentiary Minister, for the Secretary, V. Sokolovs'kyi, in Berne, [Switzerland], February 25th, 1920.

This artefact is an important testament to an essential aspect of statehood, namely diplomacy. The Ukrainian National Republic had international relations through its diplomatic corps with many countries of Europe and the Americas. More diplomatic documents of the era can be seen in an exhibition entitled ***Statehood: 100 Years of the Ukrainian National Republic*** currently on display at Oseredok. It features all the attributes of statehood, such as national insignia, currency, and military forces. All this was achieved by the Ukrainian National Republic despite civil strife, war, and lack of resources. The exhibition, with the participation of the Ukrainian Academy of Arts & Sciences of Canada, is on until **June 30, 2018**.

- ☐ Handyman jobs: minor repairs, painting, odds and ends type of jobs.
- ☐ Programs: instructors for pysanka workshops. Orientation will be provided.
- ☐ Programs: leading guided tours of exhibitions in the language of your choice (English and/or Ukrainian) for adults and/or children. Orientation will be provided.
- ☐ Exhibition installation.
- ☐ Receptions at openings and other events.
- ☐ Mailings.
