Pause in Plight

Перервана Обіцянка

The 17-piece Art Exhibit, created with support from the Endowment Council of the Canadian First World War Internment Recognition Fund (CFWWIRF), aims to inform the masses of the WW1 national security fears and wartime prejudice, which led to the internment of 8,579 men, among them, women and children, identified as "enemy aliens". Pause in Plight is touring across Canada between 2020-2025 to help bring awareness to this historical injustice. The internment art exhibit is laid out in five different sections: War Posters, Light Installation, Emotional Interpretation Series, Old Eyes Series, and To Hell with the Alien Enemy.

About Kerri Parnell

Kerri Parnell creates art that inspires community connections. Born and raised in Winnipeg Manitoba, Kerri attended the University of Manitoba-School of Fine Arts and the Nova Scotia College of Art and Design University in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Her passion is to collaborate with others on projects that promote social awareness and change. Her results are both thought provoking and aesthetically beautiful. Nowhere is this more evident than Pause in Plight.



Ця Мистецька Виставка 17-ох експонатів, була створена з підтримкою Комітету Фонду Відзначення Канадського Інтерновання Підчас Першої Світової Війни (Endowment Council of the Canadian First World War Internment Recognition Fund-CFWWIRF). Виставка має за мету інформувати населення про побоювання про національну безпеку та упередження які існували в Канаді в наслідок цієї війни. Це довело до інтерновання 8,579 осіб, включаючи жінок та дітей, котрим прив'язано назву "чужі вороги" ("enemy aliens"). Виставку "Перервана Обіцянка" показується по всій Канаді між роками 2020-2025, щоб освідомити всіх нас про цю історичну несправедливість.

Мистецька виставка про Інтерновання, показана під п'ятьма розділами: "Афіші Підчас Війни", "Монтаж Світла", Серія "Емоційних Інтерпритацій", Серія "Старих Очей", та, "До Пекла з Чужими Ворогами".

Oseredok is one step closer to fulfilling its mission to share and promote Ukrainian Canadian culture and heritage. We are happy to announce that Oseredok is getting a collections management software. This software will help us manage our vast and versatile collections: archives, museum, library and fine art, and make them available online. In the upcoming months our Museum Interns will be working hard on cataloguing Oseredok's Museum collection and making it publicly available on Oseredok's website for everyone to enjoy and explore. Prepare to be amazed!

One of the unique treasures in our holdings is the Boberskyj image collection. This collection has a tremendous significance when it comes to studying Manitoba's history and relevance to Ukrainian Canadian studies. The collection highlights one of the largest and most important pioneer immigrant groups to settle and develop the Canadian Prairies, and especially Manitoba in 1920-1929. The Boberskyj images provide a valuable pictorial record of Ukrainian community life on the Canadian Prairies. The collection mainly depicts the Prairies, especially Winnipeg and the surrounding area after 1924, documenting Ukrainian Canadian individuals, their manner of dress, and their homes, places of work, churches, and organizational buildings.

In the upcoming months this incredible collection will be digitized and made available online for you to discover!
