

	Description :	A ketts: hand made from a beige sheepkin with whice our hain for a child to a young persion. The fronts meet in the center and fracen with 3 large metal holes and eyes. The "kettar" has a stark-go collar made of white limits. All the edges of the "kettar" are trimmed with white lamb. The "kettar" is heavily ornamented with dark blue morocool learher. The kather has punched out holes which are symmetrically linter speraed with multigle study of yellow metal. Under each hole there is a small piece of glued columed learher. The kather has punched and white. The ornament is geometric and consists of on each front allog the opening. wide, rectangular piece of latebre with teeth on one long side and holeshaped extentions on the opposite side, waits pockets on each front, completely covered with latebre in blue, marroon and white elocurs; narrow, toothed on one side and of learher, along all the "keptar's" edges and straight band on the side seam, and on the shoulders. The leather is seen on with a decorative orange-yellow- black storth. The trimming on lateges are also multiple small orange-marcong-green- withe gomous (§9 had, 2), making).

Oseredok is the first in the North American Ukrainian Heritage Community to offer remote access to its collections through Online Catalog! Providing access to and promoting the Ukrainian Canadian heritage is paramount to Oseredok!

Online Catalog allows you to browse our collections remotely, whether at home, work, or traveling! If you have an Internet connection, you can visit us 24/7!

Online Catalog gives you access to our four collections: museum, archives, fine art, and library. Our collections still need to be cataloged and digitized; however, we can offer you a good representation of our holdings: 1252 museum artifacts, 1235 library holdings, 424 fine art pieces, 4583 photographs, and 600 glass slides. The Catalog is a living-breathing system that will be constantly updated as we secure funding to catalog and digitize the remaining holdings.

You can browse or search our collections using Online Catalog functionalities by object type, date, material, technique, artist, author, donor, location, etc. The video and PDF tutorials on using the Catalog are available in English and Ukrainian on our website.
