Description:	<p>A keptar, hand made from a beige sheepskin with white curly hair for a child or a young person. The fronts meet in the centre and fasten with 3 large metal hooks and eyes. The "keptar" has a stand-up collar made of white lamb. All the edges of the "keptar" are trimmed with white lamb. The "keptar" is heavily ornamented with dark blue morocco leather. The leather has punched out holes which are symmetrically interspersed with multiple studs of yellow metal. Under each hole there is a small piece of glued coloured leather in maroon, dark beige and white. The ornament is geometric and consists of: on each front along the opening, a wide, rectangular piece of leather with teeth on one long side and hook-shaped extensions on the opposite side; waist pockets on each front, completely covered with leather in blue, maroon and white colours; narrow, toothed on one side band of leather, along all the "keptar's" edges and straight band on the side seams, and on the shoulders. The leather is sewn on with a decorative orange-yellow-black stitch. The trimming on all edges are also multiple small orange-maroon-green-white pom-poms (59 in all, 2 missing).</p>

Oseredok is the first in the North American Ukrainian Heritage Community to offer remote access to its collections through Online Catalog! Providing access to and promoting the Ukrainian Canadian heritage is paramount to Oseredok!

Online Catalog allows you to browse our collections remotely, whether at home, work, or traveling! If you have an Internet connection, you can visit us 24/7!

Online Catalog gives you access to our four collections: museum, archives, fine art, and library. Our collections still need to be cataloged and digitized; however, we can offer you a good representation of our holdings: 1252 museum artifacts, 1235 library holdings, 424 fine art pieces, 4583 photographs, and 600 glass slides. The Catalog is a living-breathing system that will be constantly updated as we secure funding to catalog and digitize the remaining holdings.

You can browse or search our collections using Online Catalog functionalities by object type, date, material, technique, artist, author, donor, location, etc. The video and PDF tutorials on using the Catalog are available in English and Ukrainian on our website.

Oseredok is happy to announce the completion of the Library Cataloging Project Part 1.

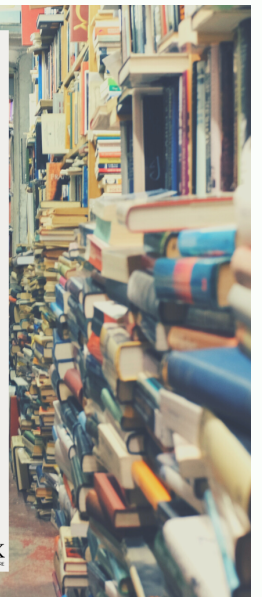
